

Example Statutory Declaration Statement for NTA - [FHOG-Form-Statutory-Declaration.pdf](#)

This is an **example only** and can be used as a guide when completing the Western Australia Statutory Declaration in the space provided after *sincerely declare as follows*:

1. That my Dogs West membership is, [XXXXXX] and I hold the Prefix [XXXXXX].
2. That I am the registered owner and breeder of the following dog(s):
 - [Dog's full registered name] – Registration No. [XXXXXX]
 - [Dog's full registered name] – Registration No. [XXXXXX]
 - [etc.]
2. That each of the above dog(s) was sold or placed in the care of another party, and ownership in practice has passed to that new owner.
3. At the time of sale or placement, it was mutually agreed that registered ownership would remain in my name. However, a Non-Transfer Agreement (as required by Regulation R11.1) was not completed.
4. I have since made all reasonable efforts to contact the current owner(s) to obtain a signed Non-Transfer Agreement. These efforts include:

5. Despite these efforts, I have been unable to obtain the required signatures from the new owner(s).
6. I now submit this Statutory Declaration as part of my participation in the R11 Self-Assessment Program, and request that this declaration be accepted in lieu of a signed Non-Transfer Agreement for the purpose of achieving compliance during the moratorium period (1 July 2025 – 30 June 2026).
