

Example Statutory Declaration Statement for TND (Transfer No Details) - [FHOG-Form-Statutory-Declaration.pdf](#)

This is an **example only** and can be used as a guide when completing the Western Australia Statutory Declaration in the space provided after *sincerely declare as follows*:

1. That I am the current registered owner and breeder of the following dog(s):
 - **[Dog's full registered name]** – Registration No. **[XXXXXX]**
 - **[Dog's full registered name]** – Registration No. **[XXXXXX]**
 - **[etc.]**
2. That each of the above dog(s) was sold or rehomed to a third party. At the time of disposal, I did not complete or submit a transfer of ownership application.
3. I acknowledge that under Regulation R11.1, I was required to transfer the dog(s) to the new owner or submit a Non-Transfer Agreement within 90 days of the change of ownership.
4. I am unable to now submit the required transfer paperwork because I no longer have the contact details of the new owner(s), due to one or more of the following:
 - Contact details were not collected at the time of sale
 - Records were misplaced, lost or damaged
 - The buyer is now uncontactable
5. I have made reasonable attempts to recover this information, but these attempts have been unsuccessful.
6. I now request that Dogs West remove the above dog(s) from my registered ownership and accept this declaration in lieu of formal transfer documentation.
7. I am making this declaration in good faith as part of the Transfer (R11) Self-Assessment Program and request that this matter be resolved under the moratorium period (1 July 2025 – 30 June 2026).
