





# Breed Lecture Invitation

It is also a requirement that 5 dogs (where possible) are made available to the trainees to examine on the night of the lecture. **This requirement is the responsibility of the trainee to organise.**

The general procedure is:

1. The group co-ordinator and lecturer (if a licensed judge) examine each dog
2. Each trainee examines each dog and writes a critique of the dog
3. The group retires to the training room after examining the dogs to discuss placings and particular virtues (& faults) of the dogs presented.
