## Matters of Governance

Following the Governing Council elections in August, Council appointed a new Chair of the Governance pillar who has extensive experience in this area. Governing Council has enabled the appointment of more Members to our Governance committees giving more flexibility and lightening the load on these Members who are also volunteers.

Work has been done and is continuing to review all our Governance processes and, with more resources in all stages of our Governance structure now, the goal is to streamline the work, provide greater transparency with improved timelines for consideration and decisions on matters.

The review of the Rules and Regulations is an ongoing project which has been impacted from time to time, but we are committed to its completion.

Governing Council is committed to ensuring that our Governance processes are fair and transparent whilst following our Constitution and Rules and Regulations.

## Annual Budget Review

The Finance Committee has begun the annual budget review that takes place halfway through each financial year. The focus is on understanding our income and expenditure for the previous 6 months and to review any budgets that show significant variance with the figures in the adopted budget.

The adopted budget shows anticipated income and expenditure for that year, based on the outcomes of previous budgets, including projected cash flows.

During the 2024 AGM, a question was raised regarding the budgeted amount for penalty income. As noted in the AGM minutes, the budget includes an estimate for penalty income; this is normal practice and reflects the historical pattern of receipts. It is important to clarify that this figure is not a target but rather a forecast of income we typically receive each year.

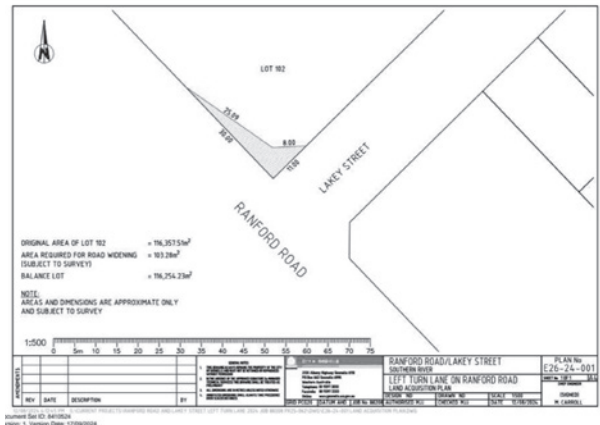

2. **BUSINESS OF MEETING**

Governing Council resolved on 23 October 2024 that a Special General Meeting be called regarding proposed sale of land to the City of Gosnells.

It was Moved:

**THAT** the sale of a portion of land measuring 103.28m<sup>2</sup> (subject to survey) to the City of Gosnells currently owned by the Canine Association of WA, as indicated on the below diagram, located within the southern corner of the landholding at the intersection of Ranford Road and Lakey Street, Southern River, be approved.



**THAT** the Canine Association of WA accepts the offer proposed by City of Gosnells for the amount of \$15,000 (fifteen thousand dollars) as full and final compensation for the identified portion of land.

**THAT** City of Gosnells pay for removal and replacement of existing fence, along the road reserve boundary of 602 Warton Road. City of Gosnells to coordinate the process of the subdivision and meet all costs associated with the carriage of this matter, including subdivision, legal, stamp duty and statutory fees but excluding any adjustment to rates and taxes at transfer.

## Rationale:

The land is required for the purposes of road widening and upgrade to the intersection of Ranford Road and Lakey Street being undertaken by the City Of Gosnells.

The Land Administration Act 1997 allows for the acquisition of land without agreement, commonly referred to as compulsory acquisition, if no agreement is reached between the parties.

The Special Meeting is to comply with the constitution of the Canine Association of WA (Inc) at Section 19- Powers of the Governing Council.

19.1.8 Sell land or any interest therein but only by resolution at a General Meeting provided notice of motion shall be given by the Member proposing to move the same to the Administrative Officer in writing, at least 90 days prior to the meeting and notice thereof shall have been included in the notice convening the meeting at which the motion was to be dealt with.

CAWA Regulation B 24 be amended by the addition of –

## B24 Postponing or Cancellation of Sanctioned Events

### 24.1 Postponing of Sanctioned Event before commencement:

24.1.1 If a Sanctioned Event is postponed before its commencement, then any exhibitor fees paid by an exhibitor to participate in that Sanctioned Event shall be credited towards the exhibitor fees for the rescheduled Sanctioned Event.

24.1.2 If an exhibitor who paid exhibitor fees to attend the postponed Sanctioned Event notifies the Sanctioned Event organiser that the exhibitor is unable to attend the rescheduled Sanctioned Event, within 7 days of receiving details of the rescheduled Sanctioned Event, then the exhibitor shall be entitled to a full refund of the exhibitor fees paid for the postponed Sanctioned Event.

24.1.3 Subject to regulation B24.1.2, if an exhibitor who paid exhibitor fees to attend the postponed Sanctioned Event does not attend the rescheduled Sanctioned Event, then the exhibitor will be disqualified and or the exhibit marked absent under regulation B23.3.5 and shall not be entitled to a refund of any exhibitor fees that were credited under regulation B24.1.1.

24.1.4 If the postponed Sanctioned Event is not held within 6 months of the postponement, then the exhibitor shall be entitled to a full refund of the exhibitor fees paid for the postponed Sanctioned Event.

### 24.2 Cancellation of Sanctioned Event prior to commencement:

If a Sanctioned Event is cancelled before its commencement, then the exhibitor shall be entitled to a full refund of the exhibitor fees paid to participate in that Sanctioned Event.

### 24.3 Cancellation of Sanctioned Event during event:

If a Sanctioned Event is cancelled after the Sanctioned Event has commenced:

24.3.1 the exhibitor shall be entitled to a full refund of the exhibitor fees paid for the Sanctioned Event;

24.3.2 the exhibitor shall not be entitled to be awarded any points, score or qualification that may have been awarded during the cancelled Sanctioned Event before its cancellation;

24.3.3 Any event incident, complaint, breach of the regulations or Code of Ethics or other disciplinary matters arising from the cancelled Sanctioned Event shall be unaffected by the cancellation and shall be dealt with under the Regulations.

## What is SprintDog™?

SprintDog™ is a brand new Dogs Australia recognised discipline (accepted as of 1/7/24) based loosely around the American Kennel Club's sport called FastCAT. Dogs are timed running down a 100m bunting chute after a lure. They run two times, the time they take to complete the 100m is averaged over the two runs and a relative km/h speed is calculated. Points are then allocated based their speed and titles are granted based on the accumulation of points.

SprintDog™ allows for any breed to participate and dogs are given a handicap rating based solely on their height with dogs under 30cm receiving a handicap of 1.5 (so the points they earn based on speed is multiplied by 1.5). Dogs between 30cm and under 45cm receive a handicap of 1.25 and dogs measuring 45cm and over receive a handicap of 1.

Western Australia has two clubs currently running events- West Coast Dog Sports and The Whippet Club of WA. Both held successful try-out sprint-style events prior to SprintDog™ becoming an official and heavily fundraised for associated equipment required. Many of their committee members undertook Judge, Driver and SprintMaster training to be ready for their first Official trials.

Our first SprintDog™ All Breeds official trials in W.A. were held on the 2nd Nov (WCDS) 9th and 16th of November 2024 (WCWA) with over 80% of run slots entered within 36hrs of entries

opening. These 3 trials not without their challenges, resulted in several dogs from multiple groups being able to now hold the title of SprintDog™ Novice having accumulated the points required.

Our SprintDog™ exhibitors have come from many different disciplines – Showing, Obedience, Agility and Lure Coursing – with different breeds representing all groups gracing the 100m chute. From a tiny Griffon Bruxellois and a speedy Cardigan Corgi, right through to German Shepherd Dogs and of course Whippets and Saluki.

# SUMMARY OF THE DOGS AUSTRALIA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING & BOARD MEETING

At the recent Annual General Meeting of the Australian National Kennel Council Limited held in Brisbane:

## 1. Election of ANKC Ltd Executive

- Mr Hugh Gent OAM was re-elected unopposed as President for a three-year term from 19 October 2024;
- Ms Pam Campbell was elected unopposed as Vice President for a one-year term from 19 October 2024;
- Mr David Sales was re-elected unopposed as Treasurer for a one-year term from 19 October 2024;
- Mr Brian Parker was re-elected as a member of the Executive Committee for a one-year term from 19 October 2024.

## 2. Increase to Overseas Judges Application Approval Fees

It was resolved that the fees for Overseas Judges approvals be set as follows effective from 1 July 2025:

- \$121.00 (incl GST) – (If lodged 9 months prior to the show)
- \$231.00 (incl GST) – (If lodged less than 9 months prior to the show)
- \$33.00 (incl GST) – (new fee applicable for each request to amend an existing approval)

## 3. ANKC Ltd Constitution – Amendment to Part 1 Objects & Related Matters, Clause 3(t)

It was resolved that the Constitution of the Company be amended by as follows:

THAT the Constitution of ANKC Ltd, Part 1: Objects & Related Matters, Clause 3(t), be amended as follows:-

Currently reads:-

- (t) *To collect, verify and publish information relating to Dogs registered in the Register of Associate Dogs and of Exhibitions of such Dogs.*

Amended to read:-

- (t) *To collect, verify and publish information relating to Dogs registered in the Register of Associate **and Sporting** Dog sand of Exhibitions of such Dogs.*

This amendment is effective from 1 January 2025.

## 4. ANKC Ltd Constitution – Amendment to Part II Objects & Related Matters, Clause 9: Definitions and Interpretation

It was resolved that the Constitution of the Company be amended by as follows:

THAT the Constitution of ANKC Ltd, Part II: Objects & Related Matters, Clause 9: Definitions and Interpretation, be amended by the inclusion of an additional Definition for "Sporting Register Dogs", as follows:-

### 9. Definitions and Interpretation

***"Sporting Dog" means a Dog that is registered with a Dogs Australia recognised Working Dog Association or Kindred Body that caters for Working, Sporting or Performance Dogs.***

This amendment is effective from 1 January 2025.

At the October 2024 Dogs Australia Board meeting, Directors resolved/ considered the following:

## 1. \*Regulations Part 2 – Judges

It was resolved that Regulations Part 2 – Judges, Section 3 be amended as follows:

Currently reads:

- 3.2 The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge

and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18)

Be amended to read:

- 3.2.1 The number of dogs any one judge may judge on any day **where that judge is only contracted to judge no more 1 Group** (excluding Group and General Specials) is 250 exhibits including Sweepstakes Classes, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body. (09/71) (Amended 10/12 – 7.5.3, 10/13 – 5.6.4) (Amended 10/17, 7.5.7 – Effective 01/01/18)

- 3.2.2 Where a Judge is contracted to judge more than 1 Group on any day (excluding Group and General Specials) is 200 exhibits including Sweepstakes Classes, except in extenuating circumstances with the prior approval of the judge and the Member Body.**

These amendments will be effective from 1 July 2025.

## 2. \*Regulations Part 5 – Conformation Shows

It was resolved that Regulations Part 5 – Conformation Shows Section 10.12 be amended as follows:

Currently reads:

### Section 10.12 Sire and Dam of Merit (Added 06/24, 5.4 - effective 01/01/ 2025)

- 10.12.1 Sire of Merit (SOM) - A dog that has produced at least ten (10) Conformation Champion offspring.
- 10.12.2 Dam of Merit (DOM) - A bitch that has produced at least five (5) Conformation Champion offspring.
- 10.12.3 At least 1 of the conformation Champion titles (CH, GRCH, SUPCH, CIB, A2O) must have been awarded after the implementation date (01 January 2025).

Be amended to read:

### Section 10.12 Sire and Dam of Merit (Added 06/24, 5.4 - effective 01/01/ 2025)

- 10.12.1 Sire of Merit (SOM) - A dog that has produced at least ten (10) Conformation Champion offspring.
- 10.12.2 Dam of Merit (DOM) - A bitch that has produced at least five (5) Conformation Champion offspring.
- 10.12.3 At least 1 of the conformation Champion titles (all conformation titles are included) must have been awarded after the implementation date (01 January 2025).

These amendments will be effective from 1 January 2025.

## 3. \*Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration

It was resolved that Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration Clauses 6.3.4.3 and 6.3.4.9 be amended as follows:

Currently reads:

- 6.3.4.3 Effective from 1 January 2016  
no 'Merle' Chihuahuas can be registered on any register and a 'Merle' Chihuahua imported into Australia cannot be registered on any register. (10/15, 6.4)

Be amended to read:

- 6.3.4.3 Effective from 1 July 2025  
Merle, Chihuahuas can only be registered on the Limited Register and notated "Never to be upgraded" once proof of breed purity and parentage has been confirmed by DNA profile.

**Be amended to read:**

6.3.4.9 Effective from 1 July 2025

Merle, long coat and hairless French Bulldogs can only be registered on the Limited Register and notated "Never to be upgraded" once proof of breed purity and parentage has been confirmed by DNA profile.

These amendments will be effective from 1 July 2025.

#### 4. \* Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration

It was resolved that Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration Clause 3.2 (d) be amended to remove the wording 'and c' in the second last row and change DAWR to DAWF as noted below:

d. *Proof of Shipment from the country of origin to Australia such as transportation documents "Airway Bill" OR an Authorised Agency under the Bio Security Act 2016, Bio Security Release form (b b ~~and c~~ above are not required if you have the DAWF DAWR release)*

These amendments will be effective immediately.

#### 5. \* Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration

It was resolved that Regulations Part 6 – The Register & Registration Section 7 be amended as follows:

##### Insert New Clause 7.5

7.5 Multi Champion

7.5.1 Dogs awarded four or more Champion Titles one title must be a Conformation Champion the other titles from any three or more of the other ANKC Ltd recognised disciplines shall be granted the title "Multi Champion" and the title shall appear before the name of the dog with the other discipline Titles indicated in brackets e.g. M.CH. [O] [T] [TS]

7.5.2 In the case of an application for a "Multi Champion" where the Neuter Champion replaces the Conformation Champion the title "Multi Champion" shall be granted and the title shall appear before the name of the dog with the other discipline titles indicated in brackets e.g. M.CH. (Neuter) [O] [T] [TS]

Consequential Changes – Renumbering of existing Rule 7.5 as 7.6 (and associated sub-rules now 7.6.1, 7.6.2).

##### Insert New Clause 7.7

7.7 Triple Grand Champion

7.4.1 Dogs awarded three Grand Champion Titles one title must be a Conformation Grand Champion the other titles from any two of the other ANKC Ltd recognised disciplines shall be granted the title "Triple Grand Champion" and the title shall appear before the name of the dog with the other discipline Titles indicated in brackets e.g. TRIPLE GR. CH. [O] [T] [TS]

7.4.2 In the case of an application for a "Triple Grand Champion" where the Neuter Grand Champion replaces the Conformation Grand Champion the title "Triple Grand Champion" shall be granted and the title shall appear before the name of the dog with the other discipline titles indicated in brackets e.g. TRIPLE GR. CH. (Neuter) [O] [T] [TS]

##### Insert New Rule 7.8

7.5 Multi Grand Champion

7.5.1 Dogs awarded four or more Grand Champion Titles one title must be a Conformation Grand Champion the other titles from any three or more of the other ANKC Ltd recognised disciplines

shall be granted the title "Multi Grand Champion" and the title shall appear before the name of the dog with the other discipline Titles indicated in brackets e.g. M.GR.CH. [O] [T] [TS]

7.5.2 In the case of an application for a "Multi Grand Champion" where the Neuter Grand Champion replaces the Conformation Grand Champion the title "Multi Grand Champion" shall be granted and the title shall appear before the name of the dog with the other discipline titles indicated in brackets e.g. M.GR.CH. (Neuter) [O] [T] [TS]

Consequential Changes – Renumbering of existing Rule 7.6 as 7.9 (and associated sub-rules now 7.9.1, 7.9.2).

These amendments will be effective from 1 January 2025.

#### 6. \* National Code of Practice of Responsible Dog Ownership

It was resolved that the National Code of Practice of Responsible Dog Ownership be amended as follows:

Currently reads:

Breeding

11. A member shall breed primarily for the purpose of improving the quality and / or working ability of the breed in accordance with the breed standard, and not specifically for the pet or commercial market.

Amend to read:

Breeding

11. A member shall breed primarily for the purpose of improving **and / or maintaining the health**, quality and/or working ability of the breed, **and for breed preservation**, in accordance with the breed standard, **and not specifically for the pet or commercial market**.

These amendments will be effective from 1 January 2025.

#### 7. \* Regulations Part 9 – Non Resident Judges

It was resolved that Regulations Part 9 – Non Resident Judges Sections 1 and 2 be amended as follows:

##### 1. General Regulations – All Judges

1.1 A Non Resident Judge must be able to verbally communicate with exhibitors to a degree that their directions and decisions are clearly understood or have a competent interpreter.

1.2 If a Non-Resident Judge is unable to read English, the Club Affiliate or Organisation conducting the event is to provide an assurance that all ANKC Ltd Rules, Regulations, Policies, Procedures and breed standards have either been translated in writing into a language understood by the Non-Resident Judge or communicated. **The assurance, signed by both the Affiliate or Organisation and the judge, must accompany the application.**

1.3 The Affiliate conducting the show must have some knowledge of the Non Resident Judge and their background and ability to judge.

##### 2. Regulations – Conformation Judges

2.1 ~~A Non-Resident Judge must be approved and have awarded in their Country of Residence Challenge Certificates, or their equivalent to a minimum of 70% of the Major breeds\* in each group as per the ANKC Ltd recognised Group/Breed list. A judge approved to judge 70% of the major breeds within a Group may judge the whole or part of the Group if split. (05/05) (Amended 10/22, 5.2, Effective 01/01/2023)~~

2.1 **Unless forbidden by the Regulations of their Country of residence, for a Non-Resident Judge to be approved to judge Group Specials in Australia, but not the individual breeds for which they are not approved at breed level, they must be approved and have awarded in their Country of Residence Challenge Certificates or their equivalent, to a minimum of 70% of the Major breeds\* in each group as per the ANKC Ltd recognised Group/Breed list.**

**\*Major Breed** a breed that has an average of 60 plus registrations over the last 3 years as recorded on the Dogs Australia Website.

2.1.1 Best in Show at Championship or CACIB Shows can only be judged by judges who are approved to judge Best in Show in their Country of Residence, provided that judge is approved by ANKC Ltd to judge at least 4 Group Specials in Australia. Alternatively, should a judge from a non FCI Country be able to judge 70% of the Breeds in each of the 7 Groups as per the ANKC Ltd recognized Group/Breed list, the ANKC Ltd may then grant permission for that judge to judge Best in Show. FCI Judges Regulation 2 e prevents this alternative being applied to FCI Judges.

## Delete current 2.2 as it is a duplication of current 2.1

2.2 ~~A Non-Resident Judge must be approved and have awarded in their Country of Residence Challenge Certificates, or their equivalent, to a minimum of 70% of the Breeds in each group as per the ANKC Ltd recognised Group/Breed list. A judge approved to judge 70% of the breeds within a Group may judge the whole or part of the Group if split. (05/05)~~

2.2 Notwithstanding the provisions in 2.1 the following Regulations are currently applied by individual National Canine Organisations.

## FCI

In accordance with FCI Show Regulations 2 e, judges from FCI National Canine Organisations may under no circumstances agree to judge a breed at any show for which they are not approved by their own NCO (National Canine Organization) and for which they are not listed in the FCI Judges Directory. The same applies for judging at Best in Group and Best in Show level.

When seeking approval to judge at an FCI International Show in Australia, a Non-Resident Judge may only apply to award the CACIB to breeds for which they are individually listed in the FCI Judges Directory, failing to comply with this requirement will result in the FCI invalidating the confirmation of the CACIBs incorrectly awarded. For non CACIB breeds listed in Appendix A to these Regulations, including the Australasian Bosdog, Murray Valley Retriever and Tenterfield Terrier, approval may be granted to award Challenges after the judge completes an ANKC Ltd Open Book Examination\* on those breeds.

## Canadian Kennel Club (CKC)

CKC Licensed judges are permitted to judge at Championship Shows in foreign countries and issue Challenge Certificates only for breeds that they are licenced for in Canada.

For breeds that are not recognised in Canada, that are listed in Appendix A to these Regulations, including the Australasian Bosdog Murray Valley Retriever, and Tenterfield Terrier, approval may be granted to award Challenges, after the judge completes an ANKC Ltd Open Book Examination\* on those breeds.

At FCI International CACIB Shows CKC judges are only allowed to judge and award CACIB's to the breeds that they are approved to judge at Championship Shows in Canada. For breeds that are not recognised in Canada but are recognised by both ANKC Ltd and the FCI on a definitive basis, and are listed in Appendix A to these Regulations, including the Australasian Bosdog Murray Valley Retriever, and Tenterfield Terrier, approval may be granted to award Challenges, after the judge completes an ANKC Ltd Open Book Examination\* on those breeds.

## The Royal Kennel Club (UK)

Where an applicant is approved by the Royal Kennel Club, to judge a group or Groups at Championship Show level, and has Open Show experience or has issued Challenge Certificates outside England, subject to compliance with 2.1, may be approved to judge at Group level in

Australia for those groups/breeds so qualified, subject to the Non-Resident Judge providing the details required, listed as follows:

- (a) Date of Open / FCI / Green Star Shows
- (b) Name of Show
- (c) List of Breed/s judged
- (d) Number of Dogs judged in each Breed
- (e) List of "any other variety" breeds judged together with the number of dogs in each breed judged. The above information is to be provided with the initial application for approval.

At FCI International CACIB Shows RKC judges are only allowed to judge and award CACIB's to the breeds that are recognised by the FCI on a definitive basis and that they are approved to judge and award Challenges to at Championship Shows in the United Kingdom.

For breeds that are not recognised by the Royal Kennel Club, listed in Appendix A to these Regulations, including the Australasian Bosdog, Murray Valley Retriever and Tenterfield Terrier, approval may be granted to award Challenges after the judge completes an ANKC Ltd Open Book Examination\* on those breeds.

## American Kennel Club (AKC)

AKC Licensed judges are permitted to judge at Championship Shows in overseas countries and issue Challenge Certificates only for breeds that they are licenced for in the USA. For Miscellaneous and FSS (Foundation Stock Service Breeds) and breeds that are not recognised by the AKC, listed in Appendix B to these Regulations including the Australasian Bosdog, Murray Valley Retriever and Tenterfield Terrier, approval may be granted to award Challenges after the judge completes an ANKC Ltd Open Book Examination\* on those breeds.

At FCI International shows, AKC judges are eligible to judge and award the CACIB provided that the following conditions are fulfilled:

1. The breeds they are scheduled to judge are recognized by the AKC (this does not include Miscellaneous and FSS).
2. They are allowed, under AKC regulations, to judge the breeds in question at AKC events and award them championship points.

For Miscellaneous and FSS and breeds that are not recognised by the AKC but are recognised by both ANKC Ltd and the FCI on a definitive basis and listed in Appendix B to these Regulations including the Australasian Bosdog, Murray Valley Retriever and Tenterfield Terrier, approval may be granted to award Challenges after the judge completes an ANKC Ltd Open Book Examination\* on those breeds.

**NB** \*Open Book Examinations will be compiled by the Overseas Judges Approval Board, will be available on the Dogs Australia Website, the completed examinations must accompany the initial application for approval

## 2.3 Now not relevant, delete in its entirety

2.3. Where a Non Resident Judge has been invited to judge a single breed, or up to three breeds at any one show then that person must be approved and have awarded in their Country of residence Challenge Certificates, or their equivalent, for that or all breeds to be judged. Where the two and/or three breeds comprise the whole show and a Non Resident Judge has been invited to judge Best in Show at the show, the Non Resident Judge must be approved and have awarded in their Country of residence Challenge Certificates to one of the breeds and must have Open Show experience in each of the other breeds, to be approved to judge Best in Show. The Open Show experience must be at least three (3) shows per breed, with a total number of dogs judged for each breed to be at least 100. (10/99)

2.4. Best In Show can only be judged by judges who are approved to judge Best In Show in their Country of Residence, provided that judge is approved by ANKC Ltd to judge at least 3 Group Specials in Australia. (05/05) 2.4.1. Alternatively should the judge be able to judge 70% of the Breeds in each of the 7 Groups as per the ANKC Ltd recognized Group/Breed list, the ANKC Ltd may then grant permission for that judge to judge Best in Show. (05/05) 2.4.2. Where a judge conforms with 2.1 that judge may judge Group Specials. (05/05)

## Delete Current 2.5 now covered by 2.2

2.5. Where an applicant is approved by the Kennel Club England to judge a group or Groups at Championship Show level, and has Open Show experience or has issued Challenge Certificates outside England may be approved to judge at Group level in Australia for those groups/breeds so qualified, subject to the Non Resident Judge providing the details required, listed as follows: (a) Date of Open / FCI / Green Star Shows (b) Name of Show (c) List of Breed/s judged (d) Number of Dogs judged in each Breed (e) List of "any other variety" breeds judged together with the number of dogs in each breed judged. The above information is to be provided with the initial application for approval of an Overseas Judge (05/05)

## 2.5 Renumbered

**2.3** Where an application has been received from a Non Resident Judge who has previously been approved by their Country of Residence's Controlling Body to award Challenge Certificates, or their equivalent, in their Country of Residence, and are currently on an "inactive" list due to being employed by their Controlling Body, and their Country's Rules and Regulations prevent them from judging in their Country of Residence, they may be approved to judge in Australia, subject to:

**2.3.1** The person has awarded Challenge Certificates, or their equivalent, in their Country of Residence within the previous ten [10] years, and;

**2.3.2** The person has judged the breeds they are seeking approval for within the last three [3] years at a recognised show conducted under the auspice of a recognised Controlling Body.

**2.4** Judges who have moved their country of residence and are not approved to judge some or all the breeds in their new country

of residence that they were approved to judge in their original country of residence, will be eligible to be approved by the ANKC Ltd to judge the breeds they were approved to judge in their original country of residence. Judges, who have been licenced by a neighbouring Country which is not their Country of Residence, shall be allowed to Judge on furnishing documentation from their Country of Residence and their Country of Licence. (05/05)

**2.5** A Non Resident Judge approved on a provisional permit or apprentice basis is not eligible for approval to Judge at Championship Shows in Australia for those breeds or Groups subject to such provisional permit or apprenticeship.

## 2.8 Now not relevant, delete in its entirety

~~2.8. A Non-Resident Judge on their first judging assignment in Australia will not be permitted to judge more than four shows in one state/territory on his first tour.~~

### Cropped/Docked Dogs of Breeds Customarily Cropped/Docked - Reminder

On the occasion of its online meeting on November 24, 2021, the FCI General Committee decided to remind the FCI Members and Contract Partners about the circular 8/2016 (dated 7/3/2016) referring to cropped/docked dogs of breeds customarily cropped/docked.

The FCI General Committee insists that, **effective from 1st January 2025**, the dogs with cropped ears/docked tail, belonging to breeds for which no reference is made to the cropped ears/docked tail in the FCI breed standards, will not be allowed anymore to be shown in any conformation event where the FCI breed standards are used.

It is up to the events' organisers to find a solution so that they are informed beforehand about the anatomy of the dogs to be shown (for example via the entry form).

## LIFE MEMBERSHIPS & DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS



Governing Council is calling for nominations for Life Memberships and Distinguished Service Awards and any Awards approved shall be presented at the Annual General Meeting in 2024.

The mandate of the Honours Committee is:-

- Long and distinguished service to the Canine Association and/or its affiliated clubs; and/or
- Service which has significantly advanced the aims of the Association; and/or
- A significant contribution to the development of breeds recognised by the CAWA.
- Such Awards shall not be awarded to a Life Member of the Association, although receipt of an Award shall not debar a member from subsequently receiving Life Membership.

A Distinguished Service Award may be awarded posthumously.

Therefore, in accordance with the above, should you wish to nominate any CAWA Member, to be considered for either a Life Membership or Distinguished Service Award, please forward the nomination and a resume relating to their contribution to the CAWA or an affiliated club, to the Administrative Officer **NO LATER THAN Friday 21 February 2025.**

All nominations are to include detail such as dates so that claims can be verified by the committee.

Recommendations are submitted to the April meeting of Governing Council.

- If there is more than 1 dog on the same number of points – a count back is taken and the dog which has been awarded the highest award is deemed to be the winner. It is deemed that a Best In Group or Runner Up In Group award is higher than a Class In Show award.
- The judging panel consists of 3 Trainee Judges who are eligible to judge General Specials.
- If any dog is unable to attend the 2nd place dog is then invited.

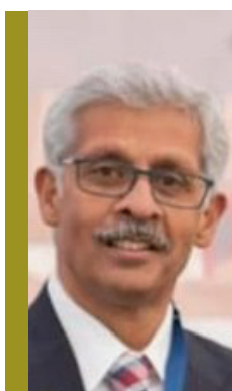
He was born into a family which loves dogs and involved with dogs since he was a child. As a junior handler, he has started to show dogs since he was fourteen years old.

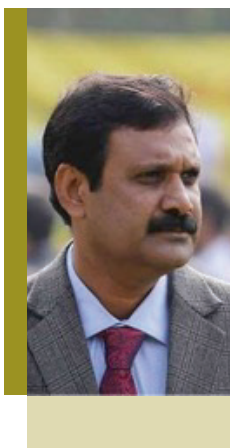


## Sharma SHHARAT (India)

The first steps into the vast and wonderful world of show dogs were taken in 1979 when I bought my first KCI Registered Labrador Bitch. The passion for Gundogs continued and I added Golden Retrievers, Irish Setters, German Short Haired Pointers and Cocker Spaniels to the kennels during the first decade. In each of these breeds I have achieved fair success and made over 20 champions. The moment of glory came in 1998-99 when his Irish Setter Ch. Eireannmada Manhattan (co- owned) was declared the Reserve Dog of the Year. The early 1990s saw a shift to Beagles and Boxers. I imported a few dogs and used other imported lines to establish a Boxer kennel. The initial lines comprised Sjecoin from Australia, Jacquets from the US and some old English lines available in India. The use of uncropped dogs from Australia along with the more stylish cropped dogs from the US helped me form a picture of the ideal head in Boxers. I have always focussed on this distinct feature of the breed with particular emphasis on the head proportions, placement of eyes, strength of

lower jaw and the shape and extent of the flews. The last ten years have seen a lot of success in the show ring. The show team was led by Am & Ind Ch, BISS, BIS Kirodyn's Trace of Emerald. He sired more than 30 Champions in India many of my own breeding. The present stock comprises a lot of Candy Kisses lines and our attempt is to consistently line breed to "Bravo and Candy Kisses dancing with Cynergy. I am proud to have bred true Boxer temperament in every litter. I have judged Boxers all over the world, but my favourite assignment thus far was the Boxer Specialty at the Pacific Northwest Boxer Club, WA, USA in August 2022. My BIS was Tybrushe's Livin Notoriety, my kind of Boxer. Granted the All Breeds Judging License in 2009, I have been fortunate to judge at most major show venues in India. I have judged prestigious international dog shows in South Africa, Philippines, Thailand, Australia, New Zealand, Indonesia, China, Malaysia, Romania, Germany, USA, Brazil and Argentina and several Speciality shows in India and abroad. I am also the founder Secretary of GURGAON KENNEL CLUB, India.

## SNAKE ADVICE

Just like many members, Dogs West is surrounded by Australian Bush and the possible appearance of snakes in the warmer months may be no surprise. Regardless, we have posted the contact details of local snake catchers throughout our grounds and if you do see one, please inform the Event Official immediately. The below is some general tips to help you in a snake spotting situation.

#### At Dogs West

For their safety, keep your dogs on a lead and within your line of sight at all times. Do not allow your dog to run off-lead on the grounds outside of the designated off-lead area.

Notify the Event Official of your sighting as soon as you can to ensure everyone nearby is aware.

#### What to do if you see a snake

1. Stand still then slowly move away if safe to do so.
2. If you are very close, keep calm, stay still and let the snake move away from you, any movement within close range might cause the snake to react, give the snake a chance to slither away.
3. Leave the snake alone, do not try to catch it, don't throw anything, don't hit it and don't yell at it. Watch the snake to see where it goes.
4. Notify Dogs West Office, and Event Official or Call a professional snake catcher if needed.

#### If you suspect your dog may have been bitten by a snake

Immediately restrain them and stop them from running around. Once restrained, get them into the car and make your way to the vet hospital.

Antivenom is commonly stocked in vet hospitals which routinely treat snake bites, but you should always call first to ensure that antivenom is available.

Each person, when signing an application for membership or renewal of membership of the Canine Association of Western Australia agrees to the following:

- to be bound by the ANKC Ltd regulations and rules
  - to be bound by the Constitution, Rules and Regulations of the Association
  - to be bound by the Association's Code of Ethics
  - To allow the inspection of the member's premises as required for the purpose of investigating compliance with the regulations and the code of ethics. **04/17**
- 1.2 Each member by signing any document shall be certifying that the information contained therein is true and correct.
- 1.3 A Member shall not forge, falsify or misrepresent the signature of another Member or person on any document relating to the activities of Dogs West or the Australian National Kennel Council Ltd. **(05/21)**

## HM2 CODE OF CONDUCT

- 2.1 A member shall not knowingly or recklessly misrepresent the ANKC or the member's Member Body.
- 2.2 A member shall not engage in any behaviour that is contrary to the standards accepted by the community.
- Members and others defined in HM2.3 will not engage in bullying or harassing or unacceptable behaviours towards other members, staff, volunteers or contractors or disorderly conduct.

- Bullying is defined as repeated inappropriate behaviour direct or indirect, whether verbal, gesture, physical or otherwise, conducted by one person or persons against another person or persons.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Cyber bullying – placing an offensive or hurtful public message, image or statement on a social network site or other public forum where that message, image or statement can be viewed and/or repeated by other people will be regarded as bullying behaviour.
- Unacceptable behaviour is defined as any behaviour that a reasonable person, having regard for the circumstances, would see as victimising, humiliating, undermining or threatening.
- Disorderly conduct is defined as disturbing the peace or endangering the morals, health or safety of others. **(07/15)**

- 2.3 Members shall be responsible for any and all actions by themselves, their family members or guests when attending sanctioned events and their interactions with other members at all times.

This includes but is not limited to:

- Littering
- Damage
- Unacceptable behaviour
- Bullying

- 2.4 A member shall not indulge in false or misleading advertising relating to the conformation, characteristics or performance of that member's dog.
- 2.5 A member shall not misrepresent nor malign the conformation, characteristics or performance of another member's dog.
- 2.6 A member shall at all times and in all forums, including at DogsWest approved events, in dealings in wider forums including chat lists on the internet and in all other communications, conduct themselves in a manner respectful of the reputation of the ANKC and DogsWest members, judges, staff and officials. **08/11**
- 2.7 An exhibitor is not to contact a judge after the announcement of that judge's appointment by any means that may be interpreted as promoting that exhibitor or exhibitor's exhibits. This includes social networking sites, email, and all electronic forms of communication as well as traditional forms of communication. Should a judge receive such an approach, they are required to make a report to the appropriate member body and disciplinary action may be taken against the exhibitor. **08/11**
- 2.8 Members shall constantly strive to improve their knowledge of their chosen

breed or breeds, and their knowledge of the requirements for the care, welfare and betterment of dogs.

- 2.9 Members shall ensure that all dogs under their control are properly controlled, housed, fed, watered, exercised and receive veterinary care as and when required. A member shall not knowingly allow any dogs under their care to roam at large.
- 2.10 A member shall permit any person authorised in writing by the Administrative Officer, following a resolution of the Governing Council, to enter and inspect any premises owned or occupied by the member for the purpose of investigating compliance with HM2.9 of this Code. 2.10.1  
During the conduct of the inspection the member will permit the authorised person to record any necessary details by tape, video or photographs.
- 2.10.2 Failure to permit the inspection of the premises without reasonable cause shall result in suspension of the member's privileges until that inspection has taken place. **(04/17)w**
- 2.11 The registered owner of a dog shall remain ultimately responsible for said dog, including if left in the care of another person.
- 2.12 A member shall take all appropriate lawful measures to assist a dog in distress.
- 2.13 A member shall positively enhance the reputation of dog breeders and owners by ensuring that dogs owned by the member are not a danger or nuisance to the community.  
When the dog is away from home a member shall ensure that it is kept on a leash and/or effective control at all times.
- 2.14 A member shall not participate in nor support any activity that involves cruelty or damage to animals, excluding legal hunting activities.
- 2.15 A member shall not dispose of dogs owned or bred by the member to a pound or animal refuge. Breed Rescue Clubs run by ANKC Ltd members are exempt. **(04/20)**
- 2.16 A member shall display good sportsmanship and conduct at all times so as to reflect credit upon themselves, the ANKC Ltd and the member's Member Body. **(08/22)**
- 2.17 A member shall at all times comply with all relevant consumer laws and regulations, both State and Federal. **(08/22) (03/23)**

## BREEDING

- 2.18 A member shall breed primarily for the purpose of improving and / or maintaining the health, quality and / or working ability of the breed, and for breed preservation, in accordance with the breed standard. A member retains the right of free trade, to advertise directly and sell dogs not kept for line maintenance purposes by that member.
- 2.19 A member shall not breed with a bitch unless the bitch has reached adequate maturity for that breed as determined by the member's Member Body. The minimum breeding age for bitches across all breeds is twelve (12) months at the time of mating. Except in extenuating circumstances or with the approval of Governing Council prior to the mating, a member shall not breed from any bitch causing it to be mated before it is twelve months of age. **(08/14)**
- 2.20 A member shall not breed a bitch causing it to whelp **more than twice in any eighteen month period (11/22)**
- 2.21 Number of Litters
- 2.21.1 A member shall not breed a bitch causing it to whelp more than five (5) times.
- 2.21.2 It is the responsibility of the current registered owner to verify the number of litters a bitch may have had prior to their ownership of said bitch. **(2/23)**
- 2.22 Maximum Breeding Age
- 2.22.1 A member shall not mate a bitch over the age of seven (7) years.  
Note: after the bitch's seventh birthday. **(07/18)**
- 2.22.2 Extenuating Circumstances
- 2.22.2.1 A member may apply to Dogs West for permission to mate a bitch over seven years of age. The application is to include:
- a veterinary certification of fitness for further breeding issued in the last **30** days
  - the positive identification of the bitch – microchip





- reasons for the need for a litter from a bitch of this age
- 2.22.2.2 The member must have obtained written permission PRIOR to mating the bitch
- 2.22.2.3 The permission is valid for a period of six months – after this permission must be re-applied for.
- 2.22.2.4 Under no circumstances will permission for a further litter be granted. **(04/17) (11/22)**
- 2.23 First generation (father/daughter, mother/son, brother/sister) matings are not permitted. ANKC Ltd Member Bodies will not register the progeny of father/daughter, mother/son, brother/sister matings on the Main Register unless application was made to the Member Body and approval was given prior to the mating on the basis of health or genetic reasons to the benefit of the breed.  
Any breach of this regulation will constitute an offence by the member(s) who are the owners of the sire and the dam of the litter.  
The progeny resulting from such a breach will be registered on the Limited Register and endorsed 'never to be upgraded' and any further penalties as may be determined by the member's Member Body. Refer ANKC Part 6 – 8.4 **(10/10) (12/14)**
- 2.24 A member shall not permit any of that members' ANKC Pure Bred Registered dogs, without prior approval from the Association, to be used in any mating which would result in a litter being ineligible for registration on the ANKC Register. This includes
  - 2.24.1 To a dog of a different breed
  - 2.24.2 To a cross bred dog
  - 2.24.3 to a non ANKC registered dog of the same breed or
  - 2.24.4 to a dog not on the ANKC Main Register
  - 2.24.5 a mating not in compliance with R2.1. **(04/21)**
- 2.25 Breaches of Regulations 2.18, 2.19, 2.20, 2.21 and 2.22 are considered to be a serious breach of the Code of Ethics. For that reason, offences in relation to each of the separate regulations will be considered cumulatively in applying penalties to the Registered Breeder/Member.  
Any puppies not registered on the Main Register are to be registered on the Limited Register with the endorsement 'Not to be upgraded to Main register'. **(08/11) (04/13)**
- 2.26 A member shall take responsible action to reduce the incidence of hereditary diseases in accordance with the ANKC Code of Practice for Hereditary Diseases.
- 2.27 A member shall not, within Australia, sell or otherwise transfer from that member's care any puppy under eight [8] weeks of age without the approval of the member's Member Body.  
Puppies are to be microchipped and vaccinated prior to leaving the Member's care.
- 2.28 A member shall not export a puppy under the age of eleven [11] weeks, or such greater age permitted under the livestock import requirements of the country to which the puppy is being exported.
- 2.29 A member shall not knowingly sell a dog to any person residing in an overseas country known to be involved in the utilisation of dogs for the meat trade without first satisfying the member's Member Body that the purchaser is a member of an ANKC recognised canine controlling body in the overseas country. The member and purchaser must further acknowledge in writing to the member's Member Body that the intention of the sale is for the improvement of the quality of that breed in the overseas country, and not for any other purpose.
- 2.30 A member shall ensure that persons acquiring dogs from that member understand the requirements for the care, welfare and responsible ownership of the dog, and that they have the time and facilities, e.g. adequate fences, sufficient room and proper shelter, to fulfil their responsibilities.
- 2.31 A breeder shall be expected to maintain reasonable contact with the purchasers of dogs from that breeder and to offer continued advice and reasonable assistance.
- 2.32 A member **must** register all puppies bred by that member that are living at the date of registration. Such registration must include all living puppies from the litter on the one litter registration application form and must be applied for within six [6] months of the date of whelping.
- 2.33 A member shall provide to all recipients of dogs sold or otherwise disposed of by

that member, written details of:

- 2.33.1 The breed characteristics;
- 2.33.2 Current Vaccination certificate signed by a Veterinary Surgeon evidencing that the dog has been immunised against Canine Distemper, Hepatitis and Parvo Virus
- 2.33.3 Microchip number verification – transfer is the responsibility of the vendor in accordance with R19.
- 2.33.4 Responsible dog ownership information; and
- 2.33.5 All documentation required by the member's Member Body, including-
  - 2.33.5.1 a written receipt clearly stating whether, in accordance with R11.1, the dog is to be transferred to the purchaser or a Non-Transfer Agreement executed. **(05/22)**
  - 2.33.5.2 any other conditions of sale and/or agreements **(04/17)**
- 2.34 A member shall not incorrectly describe nor knowingly misrepresent the characteristics of a breed.
- 2.35 A member shall ensure that all dogs sold or disposed of by that member are in the best possible state of health. Where a dog with a health issue or disability is disposed of the member must obtain from the recipient written and signed acknowledgement of the condition of the dog.
- 2.36 A member shall not:
  - 2.36.1 Sell or dispose of a dog to a commercial pet wholesaler or retail pet shop. Nor shall a member's dog/s be advertised, displayed or sold on commission by a commercial dog wholesaler or retail pet dealer. **(07/15)**
  - 2.36.2 Allow a dog owned by that member to be given as a prize or donation or to be auctioned.

## GENERAL

- 2.37 A member who provides or makes available a dog for use in a film, advertisement, promotion, or any media or public display must ensure that:
  - 2.37.1 The dog is portrayed in a manner consistent with its breed characteristics and temperament as described in the Standard for that breed; and
  - 2.37.2 The dog is presented in a manner that is unlikely to create a negative reaction to dogs generally or that breed in particular and that if there is any likelihood of a negative impression, this is at the same time corrected through the development of a story line that presents the dog or breed in a balanced manner.
- 2.38 A member shall oppose all activities which involve cruelty to dogs or in which dogs inflict damage on other dogs or other animals excluding the hunting of vermin.
- 2.39 A breeder must include their ANKC Ltd Member Body Membership Number in any advertisement for puppies whatever the media and all members must include the following wording in their advertisements:  
"Please contact Dogs West on email: [k9@dogswest.com](mailto:k9@dogswest.com) to verify my membership."
- 2.40 A member shall not use or cause to be displayed, in any form or in any media, their Dogs West membership number in relation to any progeny, real or planned, from a dog not on the ANKC MAIN register. **(06/20)**
- 2.41 A member shall not declare, make or infer any relationship, in any form or in any media, between their membership of The Association, The Association and any dog not eligible for entry onto an ANKC register. **(06/20)**

# NUTRITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR YOUR BREEDING BITCH DURING GESTATION

## WHAT, WHEN & WHY

From the moment a puppy is conceived, all throughout their life, nutrition plays a vital role. Nutritional requirements do vary and change with age, breed, life stage and lifestyle. Reproductive status also needs to be considered as pregnant bitches have very specific needs for their health and the health of their unborn puppies.

There are two distinct phases to a bitch's roughly 63-day gestation. Firstly, we have the embryonic phase for the first two thirds (6 weeks) of the gestation period. In this time, the cells of the embryo differentiate to form nerves, blood cells, skin cells, muscle cells, etc. The final trimester of gestation (week 6-9) is the foetal phase where rapid growth occurs in the foetus. These two phases have different nutritional requirements that need to be met, for the bitch to remain healthy and avoid whelping and neonatal problems down the track.

The energy requirements of the bitch in the first stage remain relatively unchanged. In the second stage, after day 42, there is a marked increase in energy requirements as this corresponds with marked foetal growth, while lactation has the highest demand for energy.

If the bitch is fed too much energy, and becomes overweight, this can be implicated in such problems from infertility, as well as whelping complications such as poor uterine contractility and an increased risk of a caesarean requirement. This dystocia can in turn lead to increased neonatal mortality.

It is important to ensure the body condition score of bitches remains ideal (4-5/9 BCS) during heat and gestation to help avoid this. Bitches should be regularly monitored throughout pregnancy for BCS to ensure their nutrition is adequate but not excessive.

There are specific nutrients that are critical for fertility, embryonic and foetal development, as well as neonatal health once born.

**Folic acid** is a B Group Vitamin important for the development of the nervous system. During embryonic development, folic acid requirements significantly increase. Deficiency can easily develop in the bitch if she does not receive adequate amounts, which can lead to increases in the risk of neural tube defects such as cleft palate, the most common congenital abnormality in puppies as well as dystocia.

A cleft palate occurs due to a failure of the roof of the mouth to close during development in the womb. This results in a hole between the mouth and the nasal cavity. Normally the palate will close around day 35, so supplementation needs to occur prior to this preferably from as soon as the bitch comes into heat. Studies have shown that folic acid supplementation during embryo development, significantly reduces the risk of cleft palate incidence.

**Omega 3 fatty acids** such as DHA (docosahexaenoic acid) and EPA (Eicosapentaenoic acid) are very important nutrients for

many functions in the body, including reproduction. These fatty acids are critical in the growth and development of the central nervous system, as well as vision for the embryo and foetus. Studies in puppies have also demonstrated a beneficial effect on learning abilities and cognitive function (trainability) with DHA supplementation. These important nutrients can also assist with the digestive and immune functions.

**Antioxidants** are another important component when considering diet as they can protect against cell damage and include vitamins C, & E, Lutein and Taurine. Beta-carotene, also with antioxidant potential, can protect the DNA and tissues, as a precursor to Vitamin A has important functions for embryo nerve, muscle and skin development. They are also thought to have a role in progesterone secretion, preparing the uterus for implantation as well as helping to maintain gestation.

An important aspect to consider with nutrition in pregnancy is **palatability** as pregnant bitches often go off their food. They may require digestive support in the form of a highly digestible diet, with a balance of fibres to support optimal gut health and function, that provides all the required energy and nutrition tailored for pregnancy as well as high palatability for bitches who may be experiencing some inappetence that may be associated with hormonal changes.

To avoid any further digestive upsets, we always suggest a gradual transition from one diet to another over 7 days, which is why the recommendation for Starter diets will appear earlier at day 35 (a week before day 42).

We recommend a tailored diet specially formulated for breeding bitches from heat to day 42 of pregnancy where the bitch should then be transitioned on to a Starter diet for the last trimester.
